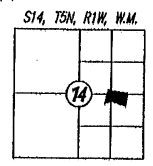

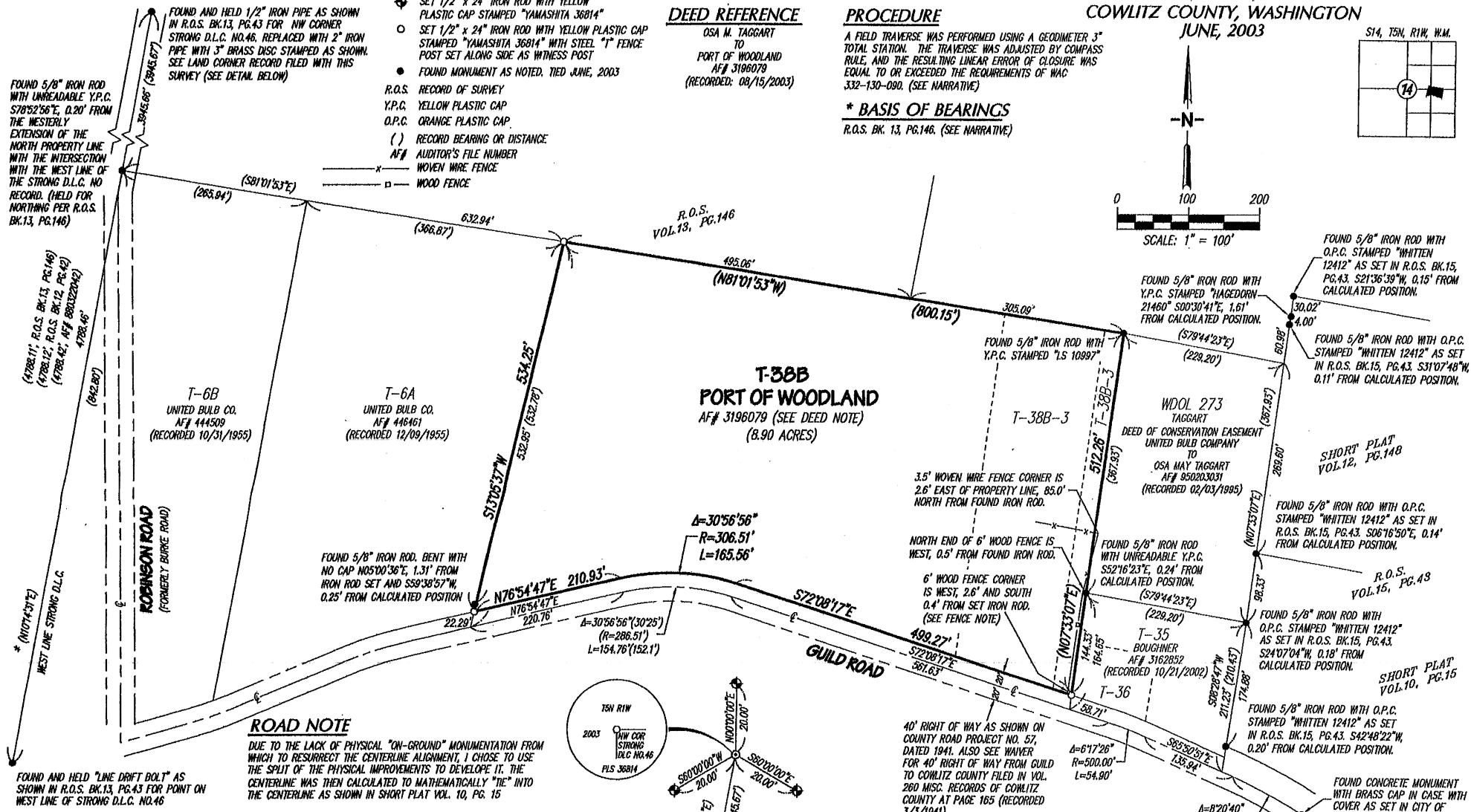
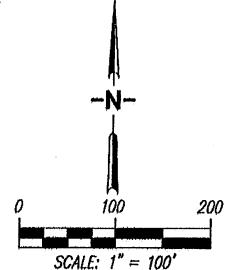

PROCEDURE

A FIELD TRAVERSE WAS PERFORMED USING A GEODIMETER 3" TOTAL STATION. THE TRAVERSE WAS ADJUSTED BY COMPASS RULE, AND THE RESULTING LINEAR ERROR OF CLOSURE WAS EQUAL TO OR EXCEEDED THE REQUIREMENTS OF WAC 332-130-090. (SEE NARRATIVE)

ROAD NOTE

DUE TO THE LACK OF PHYSICAL "ON-GROUND" MONUMENTATION FROM WHICH TO RESURRECT THE CENTERLINE ALIGNMENT, I CHOSE TO USE THE SPLIT OF THE PHYSICAL IMPROVEMENTS TO DEVELOPE IT. THE CENTERLINE WAS THEN CALCULATED TO MATHEMATICALLY "TIE" INTO THE CENTERLINE AS SHOWN IN SHORT PLAT VOL. 10, PG. 15

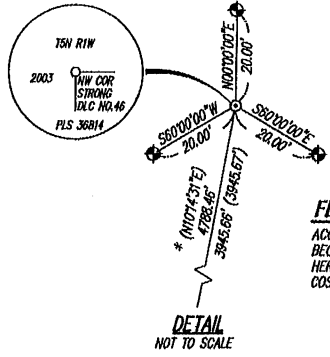
NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO CALCULATE AND MONUMENT THE REFERENCED PARCEL WHICH IS TO BE CONVEYED TO THE PORT OF WOODLAND. AN ELECTRONIC MATHEMATICAL MODEL WAS DEVELOPED FROM R.O.S. BK.13, PG.146 AND R.O.S. BK.15, PG.43. A RANDOM TRAVERSE WAS ORIENTED BETWEEN EXISTING MONUMENTS AT THE NW CORNER OF THE STRONG D.L.C. AND THE "LINE DRIFT BOLT" ON THE WEST LINE OF THE STRONG D.L.C. NOTED AS HELD HEREON. RADIAL TIES FROM THE TRAVERSE POINTS WERE MADE TO MONUMENTS SHOWN AS FOUND. FOUND MONUMENTS CHECKED SATISFACTORILY (0.10' OR LESS) UNLESS NOTED OTHERWISE. IRON RODS WERE SET BY RADIAL STAKEOUT FROM TRAVERSE POINTS.

DEED NOTE

THE BEARINGS AND DISTANCES CONTAINED IN THE LEGAL DESCRIPTION UNDER ITEM NO. 3 FOR AF# 880322042 AS REFERENCED IN THE DEED DO NOT MATCH THE BEARINGS AND DISTANCES AS SHOWN IN EXHIBIT "C", WHICH IS THE ACCOMPANYING EXHIBIT SKETCH. THE BEARINGS AND DISTANCES FROM THE SKETCH WERE USED FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SURVEY AS THEY "FIT" THE FOUND AND CALLED FOR MONUMENTATION. THE EXHIBIT SKETCH APPEARS TO INCLUDE TAX LOTS T-35 AND T-36 (BOUGHNER), HOWEVER, THIS PARCEL WAS NOT TO BE INCLUDED IN THE CONVEYANCE TO THE PORT OF WOODLAND.
